Low-Tech with Refugees exists to support refugees on the Greek island of Lesvos to develop and create ecological solutions that improve their everyday lives, by sharing their knowledge and skills to support others. Currently, the Low-tech with Refugees team is operating in the Makerspace inside the [One Happy Family - Community Center, Lesvos](#). There, we are doing repairs for bikes, electrics, sewing, weld, pottery, carpentry. Also we are running a safe space with and for women in collaboration with [Medical Volunteers International e.V.](#) within a mental health project. Our Lesvos team of both European and Refugee background consists of around 15 volunteers.
